# Middle and High School Codes of Conduct/Consequences

This list is not all inclusive and the Administration has the discretion in review of all misconduct and consequences.

## Disorderly Conduct (Level I)

## Suggested Consequences for Level I

May be an accumulation of any listed offenses

- Tardiness
  - Cheating/plagiarism
  - Lying
  - Abusive language
  - Disorderly conduct
  - Forgery
  - Cutting class
  - Dress Code Violation
  - Cell Phone use, presentation
  - Electronic Device use  
Including pagers, ipods,  
cameras, etc. w/o  
permission
  - out of authorized area
  - unauthorized tampering  
with computers, download-  
ing software, etc.
- Category A (up to 3 referrals)
  - Loss of credit (cheating, plagiarism & cutting class)  
and parent contact
  - Teacher Detention
  - Parent Conference
  - Overnight Suspension
  - (1) day out of school suspension
  - opportunity to change attire to meet code
  - Cell Phone Policy applications / parent contact
  - Category B (up to 4-5 referrals)
  - (1-2) days out of school suspension; parent/  
grandparent or Aunt/Uncle over age 21 only  
may accompany the student all day in lieu of  
suspension
  - Category C (6 + referrals)
  - (2-3) days out of school suspension

## Disruptive Conduct (Level II)

## Suggested Consequences for Level II

May include any combination within a Level

- fighting/inciting a fight\*
  - harassment
  - unauthorized presence  
on school property/at events
  - having obscene materials
  - leaving campus w/o  
authorization\*
  - deliberate refusal to obey
  - obscene language or gesture
  - possession of unauthorized  
substance (Rx, OTC medication)
  - any theft or vandalism (<\$50)
  - unauthorized assembly
  - disrupting an assembly
  - sexual misconduct/Inappropriate  
messaging (written or electronic)
  - possession of any type of  
tobacco products, lighters,  
matches, rolling papers,  
or associated paraphernalia
- Category A (1 referral)
  - Administrative Detention (1+ days)
  - Overnight Suspension
  - Restitution
  - (1-2) days out of school suspension  
parent/grandparent, Aunt/Uncle  
only may accompany in lieu of suspens.
  - Category B (2 referrals)
  - Refer to appropriate agency
  - Keep commun. item until Sem. ends
  - Restitution
  - (2-3) Suspension days
  - Category C (3+ referrals)
  - (3-5)days out of school suspension
  - “Accompany Plan” in lieu of suspension

## Disturbing Conduct (Level III)

- Improper sexual conduct / action+++
- Gambling
- Possession/display of pornographic material
- Vandalism / Theft , including computers (> \$50)
- Cruelty to animals (\*) (\*\*)
- Setting off false Fire Alarm
- Possession or transfer of a weapon+++
- Threatening any person with a weapon+++
- Threatening or intimidating other students
- Setting Fires / Igniting Fireworks
- Physically abusing or assaulting staff+++
- Threatening or intimidating school staff+++
- Bomb Threats+++
- Possession or Use of ANY illegal drugs  
including alcohol+++
- Selling drugs or alcohol+++
- Extortion(\*) (\*\*)
- Sexual Offenses+++

## Suggested Consequences for Level III (May include a Warrant)

- Out of School Suspension (5-10) days
- Restitution
- Endangering students/staff (10) days susp.
- \* First Offense Out of School suspension (5)  
days and mandatory counseling , which may be either public  
or private
- \*\*Second Offense – Recommendation for Expulsion
- +++Mandatory Recommendation for Expulsion

**(Any may include Review Board Mtg. before returning to school)**
